

Simplify Financial Faith: B, pt 2 “Debt Free”

Proverbs 22: 7 NLT

1) Abandon a broke and slave mentality

7 Just as the rich rule the poor, so the
borrower is servant to the lender.

Psalm 37: 21 NLT

2) Acknowledge your debts and pay them

²¹ The wicked borrow and never repay, but
the godly are generous givers.

Proverbs 22: 26 - 27 NLT

3) Aggressively address the topic of cosigning

²⁶ Don't agree to guarantee another person's debt or put up security for someone else.

²⁷ If you can't pay it, even your bed will be snatched from under you.

Proverbs 13: 22 NLT

4) Actively peruse and make provisions for your future generations

22 Good people leave an inheritance to their grandchildren, but the sinner's wealth passes to the godly.

Romans 13: 8*-10 NLT

5) Affection and love allows you to give freely

8 Owe nothing to anyone—except for your obligation to love one another. If you love your neighbor, you will fulfill the requirements of God's law. 9 For the commandments say, "You must not commit adultery. You must not murder. You must not steal. You must not covet."

These—and other such commandments—are summed up in this one commandment: "Love your neighbor as yourself." 10 Love does no wrong to others, so love fulfills the requirements of God's law.
