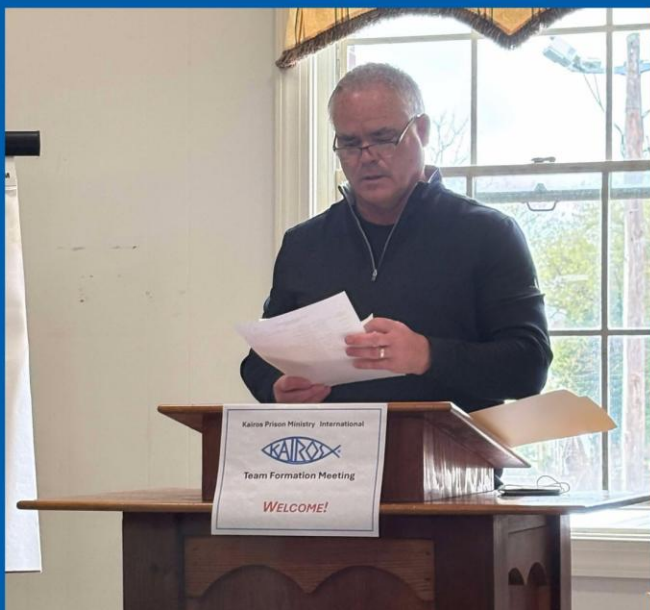

KING OF THE RING

Mark 11: 7-10 NLT

⁷ Then they brought the colt to Jesus and threw their garments over it, and he sat on it. ⁸ Many in the crowd spread their garments on the road ahead of him, and others spread leafy branches they had cut in the fields. ⁹ Jesus was in the center of the procession, and the people all around him were shouting,

“Praise God!

Blessings on the one who comes in the name of the LORD! ¹⁰ Blessings on the coming Kingdom of our ancestor David! Praise God in highest heaven!”

2) Their Misconception

¹² " ...A large crowd of Passover visitors ¹³ took palm branches and went down the road to meet him. They shouted, "Praise God! Blessings on the one who comes in the name of the LORD! Hail to the King of Israel!"

John 12: 14-15 NLT

3) The Messianic Prophecy

¹⁴ Jesus found a young donkey and rode on it,
fulfilling the prophecy that said:

¹⁵ “Don’t be afraid, people of Jerusalem.
Look, your King is coming,
riding on a donkey’s colt.”



John 12: 17-18 NLT

4) They Came to See the Miracle Work

¹⁷ Many in the crowd had seen Jesus call Lazarus from the tomb, raising him from the dead, and they were telling others about it. ¹⁸ That was the reason so many went out to meet him—because they had heard about this miraculous sign.



John 12: 19 NLT

5) The Haters were Mad and Couldn't do a Single Thing

¹⁹ Then the Pharisees said to each other,
“There’s nothing we can do. Look, everyone
has gone after him!”
